Democracy: Making decisions together

Encourage children:

To see their role in the class, the community and the wider world.

To know their view counts

To appreciate others opinions, likes and dislikes

To make choices about their learning and environment

Individual liberty: freedom for all

The EYFS curriculum develops the children's self-confidence and self-awareness through Personal Social and Emotional Development (PSED) and understanding of the world

Opportunities are given for children to develop their self-knowledge and confidence in their own abilities.

Rule of Law: Understanding rules outlined in our EYFS curriculum

The EYFS curriculum has a focus on managing feelings and behaviour.

Staff ensure children understand right from wrong

Staff discuss and create the rules with the children ensuring the same rules apply to everyone.

Community members invited in to talk about keeping safe, keeping safe through being aware of rules.

Mutual respect and tolerance: Treat others as you want to be treated

Strong link to the EYFS curriculum with people and communities, managing feelings and behaviour and making relationships.

We celebrate diversity with the promotion of cultures and religions discussing similarities and differences.
